10 2020-21	<p><b>Calanigan Elementary School, Province of Isabella in the Philippines – WASH (RAOAF)</b></p> <p>To provide The Calanigan Elementary School, in Barangay Calanigan, Municipality of Sto.Tomas, Province of Isabella in the Philippines. Water well, storage tank, water stations with filtration system, repair of wash area and existing toilets. Provision of clean water, training on sanitation, hygiene and water conservation</p>
8 2020-21	<p><b>2020 Timor Rotary Consortium – WASH (RAOAF)</b></p> <p>The main focus of the project is for the installation of water tanks, roof guttering, pipelines from local springs to the water tanks and toilets in remote village schools and communities in the Bagueia and Viqueque regions of eastern Timor Leste.</p>
L15 2020-21	<p><b>Warringa Park School -Werribee South Campus (RABS)</b></p> <p>Provision of indoor/outdoor equipment, play equipment and various interactive educational games. This equipment will assist children with special needs to develop educational and development skills. Provide an E Learning table interactive [electronic screen touch table] and foam playground equipment.</p>
23-2020-21	<p><b>FORaMEAL – nutritious food to people in need within Australia (RABS)</b></p> <p>The project aims to prepare and distribute nutritious food packs, called FORaMEAL, free of charge to people in need within Australia who have been significantly affected by natural disasters like cyclones, floods, droughts, fire and pandemics etc. The food packs will be prepared by volunteers, including Rotarians from many Clubs. The food packs will be supplied to Rotary Clubs and other organisations who are involved in distributing aid in the areas where the disaster occurred. With the Covid pandemic currently in Australia, refugees &amp; overseas students who are not citizens and have lost their jobs are in great need for food.</p>
27-2020-21	<p><b>Urgent Food Relief for Cambodians (RAOAF)</b></p> <p>Supporting the Rotary Club of Phnom Penh with funding and personnel when able, to support 100 families in 4 villages facing starvation due to the Covid 19 pandemic. These people are facing starvation after five months without income support because family members working in the tourism and garment industries in Phnom Penh and Seim Reap have been stood down from work, due to the lack of tourists and the immediate closure of the garment and clothing industries through lack of trade from overseas. The Club works closely with the commune chief to identify the families most in need.</p>
32-2020-21	<p><b>Maternity Kits for Sri Lanka (RAOAF)</b></p> <p>This project is to provide a complete set of supplies required by pregnant mothers who live below the poverty line in Sri Lanka. About 10-20% of pregnant women have insufficient funding to purchase the essentials such as, baby blankets, re-usable nappies, towels and baby clothing to take with them to the maternity hospital for their delivery.</p>
