

## Water Sanitation Hygiene Save Lives, Southern Region RAWCS

While the pandemic exist, there are some movements from WASH D9800. There have been no enquiries or reports from other Southern Region Districts.

I am pleased to report the following from District 9800, report by country:

Philippines:

1. Pasil Elementary School, Kalinga Northern Phillipines – completed 3 toilet blocks with WASH stations. Included are complete training on Sanitation and Hygiene. Partners and stakeholders: Rotary Club of Hawthorn, Partners in Aid, Pasil Community Assn. No Host Rotary Club involved.
2. Nambaran Elementary School, Kalinga – on hold as entire area in lockdown
3. Calanigan Elementary School – provision of clean water, toilet block, wash stations. Completed. Partners: Rotary Club of Yarraville, Rotary Club of Greater Marikina Valley District 9800, D3800
4. Morong National High School under investigation : construction of toilet block & provision of literacy aids.
5. Luzon Philippines – 4 provinces (Nueva Ecija, Batangas, Rizal, Quezon) provision of MacLean water and station
6. Barra, Lucena Quezon Philippines – this is a global grant clean water pipeline with water cluster station project. Still in progress.

Kirribati:

7. Tarawa, Kirribati – under investigation is the need for provision to construct toilet blocks with water stations. Partners: Rotary Club of Tarawa and Partners in Aid.

Laos :

8. Clean water and Toilet Blocks were completed as part of a school building project. Sponsor: Rotary Club of Central Melbourne

Vanuatu-

9. Eppi Island, Vanuatu - construction of 16 toilet block units. In progress. Partners: Rotary Club of Melbourne and Rotary Club of Port Vila

South Sudan –

10. South Sudan - not a project as yet. Discussions in place whether involvement is feasible due to political / war zone issues. My assistance was called for, to preview and project a feasibility study, assessment of the viability of this project, along the context of the Rotary International guidelines.

Location: South Sudan, province of Warrap, Village of Liu Still.
