Dental Teams for Tonga Dental Health Project

Dental teams for Tonga is a joint project of RC Ballarat West and RC Keilor, partnering with DIK to establish and equip dental clinics at three Tongan secondary schools and a sick bay and library at one of the schools. Much of the equipment has been donated including dental chairs, autoclaves and complete

sets of dental equipment from three retiring dental surgeons from Melbourne. A detailed PowerPoint description is attached to this report.

Solomon Islands National Referral Hospital Dental Clinic

The Solomon Islands project is on hold due to COVID 19 restrictions.

Renovate and Repair Clinic at Klibur Domin, Timor Leste

There has been no activity on this project in the last quarter due to COVID 19 restrictions.

Dental Prosthetic Laboratory for Port Vila & Vanuatu Dental Project

These projects are now both closed but the facilities are being used by local entities.
