More Buffalo will be financed incrementally, with the aim of establishing a dairy for the school to run as a means to finance more educational opportunities for impoverished students in the local area and to provide nutritional supplies to the students from the income from the sale of the Water Buffalo Milk.

75-2020-21: Rebuilding post-Cyclone: Healthy Villages for Children in West Timor (RAOAF)

Description: East Nusa Tenggara province (NTT) is the poorest province in Indonesia. Children's health is a central focus in rebuilding for healthy villages in West Timor. We will assist Children to achieve their potentials by rebuilding safer houses to include floods protection, and protection against disease-carrying insects. We will improve Children's access to water and sanitation; and improve their nutrition by establishing food security via food gardens at homes and/or at schools. Pre-school education facilities will be improved with rebuilding and access to educational materials. Also, community-based integrated health posts "Posyandu" will receive assistance for child health services such as growth monitoring and health education to parents.
