

The needs on healthcare, principally due to the pandemic has been the focus of this WASH module. In the last 6 months, the focus of Water Sanitation and Hygiene is towards implementing WASH not only in communities but also in hospitals and healthcare facilities.

On Fighting Disease save lives -Covid Pandemic

1. Through request of RI Foundation, the global grant project on the medical mobile van for for screening, testing, swabbing, immunisation of poor communities was outfitted with a healthcare facility and WASH facility. Writing an operation guideline manual in progress.

Status: Medical Van in use. WASHinHCF operation manual in Progress.

On Water Filtration –

2. RC of Keilor East with RC of Passport Melbourne - Cambodia:
 Water Filtration system to be implemented/piloted to four schools in Cambodia. D9800 District grant submitted with partnership of Keilor East RC and Passport Club. Technology to be used is the Sky Hydrants system; to serve 500-1000 students. **Status: Grant Application in progress.**

3. RC of Wagga Wagga

A new model of water filtration (PackWash) was presented (virtual) by RC of Wagga Wagga. Ideal for pilot in Pacific islands and the Philippines. **Status: Refer to Rotary clubs to implement**

On WASH - Water Sanitation Hygiene:

Philippines:

4. Central and northern Luzon: Six project proposals under review and being assessed. Progressive discussions with Rotary clubs and communities in the Philippines. REFER PDG Iven Mackay and Rtn Cecily Neil, discussion topic and proposals.

Status: In progress. Project sponsors needed.

5. Lucena Quezon – Water pipeline distribution with cluster water stations. GHD contractor did water well testing. Due to continuing poor test results, project to be cancelled .

Status: For cancellation with TRF.

6. Nakar, East northern Luzon, Quezon – assessment on water pipeline distribution for Barangay Calibangan, Quezon – school and community. **Status: In Progress**

Cambodia

7. Siem Reap, 350 toilets and 100 water wells installed. RC Central Melbourne & World of Difference. Further \$12,000 funding needed for toilets & wells. **Status: Application in progress.**

Vanuatu-

8. Eppi Island, Vanuatu - materials for construction of water wells and toilets to be fully delivered to Eppi. Partners: RC Melbourne & Rotary Club of Port Vila **Status: IN PROGRESS**

Kirribati –

9. Tarawa, Kirribati

Under investigation is the need to construct toilet blocks with water stations. Partners: Rotary Club of Tarawa and Partners in Aid. **Status: Invite Australian RC to participate.**

10. South Sudan –

South Sudan - Requested proposal on water distribution. Ruth provided an assessment review of the project viability, through to a business model per a project template (RI guidelines) to the South Sudan stakeholders. Province of Warrap, Village of Liu . **Status: Awaiting response**
